



DESIGN/INSTALLATION REQUIREMENTS

In order for your glass installation project to advance smoothly, it is necessary for the following conditions to be met prior to starting the glass design/installation process.

- Tile and grout or any mounting surface (granite, seats, 1/2 walls, etc) should be complete and area should be clear of debris and ready to receive shower glass.
 - Vanity countertops and backsplash should be installed and ready for proper mirror measurements and installation.
 - If installing mirrors with cutouts for light fixtures, the fixtures must be removed and electrical wires should be tucked into wall box.
 - Cabinet glass doors should be installed and ready to receive glass.
 - If installing mirrors or glass in specific locations such as builder-provided wood trim, trim should be complete and ready to receive mirrors and glass.

Comal Glass Company can successfully measure and install all glass within 2 trips if the above conditions are met. If a jobsite is not properly prepared for glass measuring/installation, there will be a \$500 trip charge added to the final invoice for each subsequent trip.
